Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years

From 1820 to 1840 Irish Immigrants with others built the canals that surround Lynchburg. This gave a boost to the Roman Catholic presence. A priest would come once in a great while to celebrate mass. Some of the Immigrants settled in. During the Civil War the Daughters of Charity were some of the nursing groups who served the wounded on both sides of the conflict. We know that the North had never taken Lynchburg. They had defeated the Yankees (and the Red Sox). The Daughters stayed and a more stable priest presence came. Eventually, the grandchildren and children of the Irish Immigrants built Holy Cross Church in 1878. Holy Cross Church on 710 Clay Street still has the original stained glass window. Notice the Irish names on each one who made the donations.

To provide a little inspiration during the current health crisis, I will devote the month of April to stories of the heroism of Virginia Catholics in past epidemics. Throughout the nineteenth century, yellow fever was a periodically recurring plague faced by Virginians. During an 1855 yellow fever epidemic concentrated in Norfolk and Portsmouth, two thousand people died in these cities alone. While many Protestant clergy fled the area to escape the contagion, the two local Catholic priests and the religious sisters of the Daughters of Charity courageously stayed behind to care for the afflicted and minister to the suffering.


