From 1877 to 1883, a group of idealists attempted to construct a model Catholic community in rural Charlotte County, Virginia. Named "Keileyville," after the president of the Irish Catholic Benevolent Union, this Catholic colony attracted 120 residents who farmed the land and built a church. Financial mismanagement and crop failures doomed the colony, but timbers from its church survive, repurposed to help build St. Catherine of Siena Church in Clarksville, Virginia.
