Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years

Augustine van de Vyver—the sixth bishop of Richmond (1889-1911) - initiated the diocese's first "mission band." Starting in August 1906, a small group of three priests were assigned to hold short-term missions at both the diocese's established churches and at any location in the diocese where Catholics existed without a church. This barnstorming model of missionary activity would be continued by later bishops, assisted by the rise of the automobile.
