Memorable Moments in Diocesan History

Upon his return from the Second Vatican Council, Bishop Russell immediately began implementing reforms in the diocese. His 1966 diocesan synod endorsed the "folk mass" and the use of the guitar as an instrument in worship. The same synod called for the development of a Newman Club or Newman Center at every public college in the diocese and for the inclusion of ecumenism as part of the curriculum of every Catholic school in the diocese.
